COPY OF A RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE BRITISH COLUMBIA
MOUNTAINEERING CLUB AT AN EXECUTIVE MEETING HELD ON
THE 15th DAY OF OCTOBER, 1915.

"THAT it is desirable in the public interest to have a park
reserve created in the Mount Garibaldi District, to include all
those portions which have a greater elevation than three thousand
feet above sea-level in the area bounded by the Mamquam and Pitt
Rivers and the main stream and east branch of the Cheakamus River,
so that its remarkable assemblage of glacial, volcanic and other
natural features may be preserved unimpaired for the instruction
and recreation of the people of Western Canada."
