Administrative History

ICICS was founded in 1985, as the Centre for Integrated Computer Systems Research (CICSR), to promote interdisciplinary research among the three founding departments of Electrical and Computer Engineering, Computer Science, and Mechanical Engineering at the University of British Columbia. In November 2000 CICSR's name was changed to the Institute for Computing, Information and Cognitive Systems (ICICS). The scope of the institute was broadened to include emerging human-centered technologies research and membership eligibility was opened to any UBC faculty member pursuing this type of research. The Institute has grown from 30 members in 1986 to 150 in 2012.

Directors of the institute include Jim Farah - Faculty of Computer Science (1986-1996), Rabab Ward - Faculty of Electrical and Computer Engineering (1996-2007), Nimal Rajapakse - Faculty of Mechanical Engineering (2007-2010), and Panos Nasiopoulos - Faculty of Electrical and Computer Engineering (2010)

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of the records of various committees associated with CICSR between 1986 and 1996. These are advisory committees that report on issues such as academic and campus computing, science education and continuing education at the University of British Columbia.

The fonds is maintained in the original order in which it was received. It is divided into seven files according to subject matter. The fonds consist of textual materials including memoranda, correspondence, meeting minutes and agendas, reports, written notes and other printed materials.
