Administrative History

The Centre for Teaching and Academic Growth (TAG) was founded in 1987, first under the name of the Centre for Faculty Development and Instructional Support. TAG's offices were first located in the Continuing Studies building, they later moved to the David Lam building in 1996, and finally to the Irving K. Barber Learning Centre in 2008. TAG's mission was "to foster quality teaching and learning across the University... [to] take a leadership role in addressing professional development needs for current and future practitioners in higher education... [and to] create a supportive learning environment in which to explore teaching practice and reflect upon a range of contemporary instructional issues." TAG facilitated a number of events to support teaching at UBC including symposiums, seminars, and workshops. Perhaps most notably, the annual TAG Institute provided a free two-week intensive seminar and workshop series for instructors.

In July 2010 TAG, the Office of Learning Technology (OLT), and the Institute for the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning, merged to form the Centre for Teaching Learning and Technology (CTLT).

Custodial History

The materials were transferred to the University Archives by the Centre for Teaching Learning and Technology (CTLT) in 2025.

Scope and Content

This fonds consists of records relating to the activities of the Centre for Teaching and Academic Growth (TAG). The majority of materials in the fonds are publications relating to specific events sponsored by TAG or newsletters produced by TAG.
