Biographical Sketch

David F. Aberle was an American anthropologist and author. Born in 1918 in St. Paul, Minnesota, Aberle completed a PhD in Anthropology at Columbia University in 1947. After returning from a stint overseas during World War II, Aberle began his academic career teaching at Harvard University between 1947 and 1950. Having previously worked in New Mexico studying the Navajo and Hopi, for two summers in 1949 and 1950, Aberle worked for the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs in Window Rock, Arizona where he developed an enduring interest in Navajo culture and land rights in the Southwestern United States.

Pursuing extensive field research in Arizona in the 1960s and into the 1970s and 1980s, Aberle studied Navajo kinship patterns, economic development and the Peyote religion among the Navajo. He also became an active participant in the Navajo-Hopi land dispute before the American courts in the 1970s, 80s and 90s which centered on the issues surrounding historical land occupation, removal to Reservation lands, land use and grazing rights between the Navajo and Hopi tribes in Arizona. Aberle collaborated on a variety of exploratory reports on the subject, and participated in an American Anthropological Association Ad Hoc Panel on Navajo-Hopi land claims which made recommendations to the courts and government agencies involved in the case.

From 1952 to 1960, Aberle taught in the Departments of Sociology and Anthropology at the University of Michigan, moving to Brandeis University in 1961 and to the University of Oregon in 1963. Aberle and his wife, Kathleen Gough Aberle, also a professor at Brandeis and Oregon, left the United States in the wake of some controversy surrounding Gough's stated position regarding the Cuban Missile Crisis, which Aberle supported. Both Gough and Aberle were known to have Marxist leanings and openly challenged the U.S.'s position toward Cuba and the war in Vietnam and actively sought university postings in Canada. Moving to Vancouver, Aberle taught at UBC in the Department of Anthropology and Sociology from 1967, becoming Professor Emeritus in 1984.

The contributor to a number of volumes, and author of a number of essays and articles, in 1962 Aberle published the book *Chahar and Dagor Mongol Bureaucratic Administration: 1912-1945*. In 1966, Aberle published *The Peyote Religion among the Navajo* and in 1974 he

published *Lexical Reconstruction: The Case of the Proto-Athapaskan Kinship System* with Isidore Dyen. The majority of Aberle's academic career was focused on his work with the Navajo in the Southwestern U.S. David Aberle died in 2004.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of material related to David Aberle's research activities, academic work and writing. It includes the notebooks and journals of his fieldwork beginning in 1940-41 and continuing through 1991. These consist primarily of fieldnotes and other notes made during and after those trips. The vast majority of this material relates to Aberle's work with the Navajo in Arizona. The fonds also includes notes, articles, data and codes relating to Aberle's research into kinship and language among the Navajo, Mongols and Athapaskans, and extensive research into Navajo cultural and economy. The fonds also includes correspondence on a variety of academic subjects, Aberle's teaching materials from UBC's Department of Anthropology and Sociology, his work, including a number of reports written as part of, the Navajo-Hopi land dispute. Finally, the fonds includes the research for and manuscripts of a number of Aberle's essays and articles, as well as chapters and appendixes of his books.

Series Descriptions

Academic Records Series. – 1939-1993.

Series consists of Aberle's own academic transcripts and essays, his teaching materials from the Department of Anthropology and Sociology at UBC and correspondence relating to various teaching positions held by Aberle. The series includes correspondence, drafts and notes relating to various lectures given by Aberle as Professor Emeritus and after his retirement.

Correspondence Series. – 1940-1993.

60 cm of textual records.

Series consists predominantly of Aberle's professional correspondence relating to work, teaching, writing, his associations and his work with the Navajo in Arizona. The series also includes some personal correspondence with his wife, Kathleen Gough, and concerning the war in Vietnam, accusations of nepotism relating to Gough and Aberle's personal connections and teaching appointments and surrounding Gough's statements about the Cuban Missile Crisis.

Grants Series. – 1951-1983.

13 cm of textual records.

Series consists of Grant applications by Aberle to a variety of funding bodies in the United States and Canada.

Published Works and Papers Series. – 1940-1990.

84 cm of textual records.

Series consists of notes and correspondence relating to, and drafts of Aberle's books, articles and essays. The series includes a number of draft chapters for Aberle's book on Navajo Peyotism.

Notebooks, Journals and Interviews Series. – 1940-1991.

99 cm of textual records.

Series consists of Aberle's handwritten field notes and journals, as well as printed transcriptions of those notes and journals. The series also includes interview transcripts from interviews conducted during Aberle's fieldwork. The majority of the notes and

journals are from Aberle's work with the Navajo, also some include work pursued in Mongolia and for his work on the Athapaskans.

Navajo-Hopi Land Dispute Series. – 1934-1996.

99 cm of textual records.

Series consists of notes, research, correspondence, panel and committee findings and reports and press clippings on the Navajo-Hopi Land Dispute in Arizona in the 1960s-1990s. The series includes a number of reports, and the accompanying research, correspondence and interviews, on the land dispute which were used for fact finding for the court cases and Senate hearings on the subject.

Research Series. – [1897-].

3.83 m of textual records.

Series consists of notes, questionnaires, articles, data, statistical analysis, codes, publications and government reports relating to Aberle's research into the Navajo and Peyotism, but also his work on kinship, language, culture and religion general.

Much of the material is undated. The remainder is arranged in chronological order.

Photographs Series. – 1965 - 1991.

1443 photographs.

Series consists of black and white and colour photographs, slides and negatives of Navajo people, scenes and land accompanying Aberle's fieldwork in Arizona. The series also includes some photographs of Aberle and his family, and Aberle in Arizona.
