# **Administrative History**

In 1915, when UBC first offered classes, Sociology was combined with Economics and Political Science in a single department. However, it was not until 1921 that the first Sociology course, "Principles of Sociology", was taught by Samuel E. Beckett. The first master's degree in Sociology was conferred in 1928. A year later, Coral Wesley Topping was the first sociologist to hold a full-time position at UBC, who worked to introduce further sociology course offerings.

Topping retired in 1955 and anthropologist Harry Hawthorn became the head of the new Department of Anthropology, Criminology, and Sociology. In 1959, the department was renamed again to the Department of Anthropology and Sociology. The first PhD programs were introduced by the Department in the late 1960s, making UBC the second university in Canada to offer a PhD in anthropology.

In 1968, Harry Hawthorn was replaced by anthropologist Cyril Belshaw as department head. Throughout the 1970s, the Department worked to expand with additional tenure-track positions and academic publishing in both sociology and anthropology. In 1976, the Museum of Anthropology (MOA) moved into its new building designed by Arthur Erickson with a newly renovated space for the Department nearby.

In the early 1980s, the Department of Anthropology and Sociology divided their programs into the two separate streams available today, Anthropology and Sociology. They each developed their own unique committees, standards, and graduate regulations, although some records are still created under the joint Department of Anthropology and Sociology.

Today, the Department of Anthropology and the Department of Sociology conduct original research throughout British Columbia and around the world.

# **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of textual records and architectural drawings related to the activities of the Department of Anthropology and Sociology. The majority of records relate to the Department's core functions, including course planning and delivery, honours theses, administrative activities, and new and/or renovated buildings for use by the Department.

Fonds is arranged in the following series: Administration series; Program and Course Materials series; Departmental Bulletin series; and Building Plans and Materials series. The Administration series also consists of four sub-series: Financials; Committee Materials, Meeting Minutes, Reports and Review Documents.

Fonds consists of institutional records – access requests must be reviewed by the University's FOIPOP Coordinator.
