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Fonds Description

Faculty of Arts fonds. – 1950-2003.

33.48 m of textual records and other materials.

Administrative History

The Faculty of Arts was one of the three original faculties of the University of British Columbia. Renamed the Faculty of Arts and Science in 1922, it administered all departments and programmes in the natural, physical and social sciences, humanities, and creative arts. By 1962 the Faculty had about half of the University's total enrolment and was responsible for three-quarters of academic instruction. The resulting administrative complexities led to its division in 1963 into the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Science. The reduced Faculty of Arts included the Departments of Anthropology and Sociology, Asian Studies, Classics, Economics and Political Science (split in 1964), English, Fine Arts, Geography, German (renamed Germanic Studies in 1976), History, Music, Philosophy, Psychology, Romance Studies, and Slavonic Studies, plus the Schools of Home Economics (renamed Family and Nutritional Sciences in 1984), Librarianship (renamed Library, Archival and Information Studies in 1985), and Social Work.

Since 1963 the Faculty has added the Departments of Religious Studies (1965), Creative Writing (1965), Theatre (1965, renamed Theatre and Film in 1991), and Linguistics (1969). In addition, Romance Studies was split into the Departments of French, and Hispanic and Italian Studies in 1967, and Music was reorganized as a School in 1987. Since 1990, Slavonic Studies has been disbanded, Family and Nutritional Sciences has been transferred to the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences, and departmental mergers (forced in part by financial constraints) have created the Departments of Classical, Near Eastern and Religious Studies, and Theatre, Film and Creative Writing. The Faculty of Arts continues to provide instruction and facilitate research in the humanities, social sciences, and creative arts.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of correspondence, minutes, reports, financial records, and published materials created or acquired by the Office of the Dean of Arts in the course of the administration of the Faculty. Also included are architectural plans of the Buchanan Building and other campus facilities. The records are arranged in the following series: Faculty of Arts Meetings, Heads & Directors Meetings, Committees, Budgets, Asian Centre, Museum of Anthropology, Space and Building Allocation, Statistics, Student Relations, Department and Programme Correspondence, Departmental Reviews, Faculty and Departmental Reports, UBC Non-Departmental Correspondence, General

Correspondence, Development/Projects, Architectural Plans - University of British Columbia, and Architectural Plans and Drawings from the Dean of Arts Office.

Dr. Sherrill E. Grace served as an Associate Dean of Arts 1991-1994.

Sous-fonds consists of records created or accumulated by Dr. Sherrill E. Grace in her role as Associate Dean of Arts. Records include correspondence, minutes, reports, and other textual records pertaining to Grace's interaction with various departments in the Faculty of Arts and her involvement in various university and external committees.

Sous-fonds has been arranged into two series: Arts Department records and Committees records.

Dr. Graeme Wynn sous-fonds. – 1977-1996.

3.14 m of textual materials.

A Professor of Geography at the University of British Columbia, Dr. Graeme Wynn served as Associate Dean of Arts between 1991 and 1996. At the end of his term as Associate Dean of Arts, Wynn became head of the Department of Geography.

Sous-fonds consists of records created or accumulated by Dr. Graeme Wynn as Associate Dean of Arts. Records relate to Wynn's general activities within the Faculty of Arts, his role in the development of Faculty of Arts policies and procedures, courses, programs, and events, and his involvement and interaction with Faculty of Arts departments, university and external committees, the President's Office, and affiliated and non-affiliated colleges and university-colleges. Includes correspondence, minutes, reports, financial records, brochures, newsletters, and other textual records.

Sous-fonds arranged into the following series according to the original arrangement of records: Arts departments records (1993-1995), Colleges and University Colleges records (1989-1996), Committees records (1979-1996, predominant 1990-1996), Faculty of Arts records (1977-1996, predominant 1991-1996), President's Office records (1994), Ritsumeikan records (1990-1997), and Students records (1993-1995).
