#### **Biographical Sketch**

Poet Robert Bringhurst was born in 1946 and raised in the Canadian Rockies. He attended M.I.T, the University of Utah and Indiana University. Returning to Canada after a prolonged residence in South America, Europe and the Near East, Bringhurst joined the Department of Creative Writing at the University of British Columbia. He authored several books including *Bergschrund* (1975), *Tzuhslem's Mountain* (1982) and *The Beauty of Weapons: Selected Poems* (1983). He also served as co-editor of *Visions: Contemporary Art in Canada* (1983) which was the first work to document the various movements in Canadian art since World War II.

#### **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of multiple drafts and the original typescript for the book *Visions: Contemporary Art in Canada*. Fonds also includes correspondence with various authors and promotional material for the book.
