## **Administrative History**

The UBC Film Society was founded in 1936. Like all student clubs it operates under the authority of the Alma Mater Society. Its objective was – and continues to be – to bring to campus high-quality films of various genres and levels of popularity that students may not otherwise have the chance to see.

## **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of issues of the Film Society newsletter the “Daily Crimes” (1965-66), an informational pamphlet about the Society (1968), and programmes published by Cinema 16 (originally a subsidiary of the Society) and the Vancouver Film Society (1965-66).
