Biographical Sketch

George Philip Haddock was born in San Diego, California in 1913. He completed his B.S. in forestry (1934) and Ph.D. in plant physiology (1942) at the University of California, Berkeley. After graduation, Haddock enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Force where he served until 1945. He then assumed his first teaching position at the New York State College of Forestry. In 1946, he returned to the West coast to become Assistant Professor of Silviculture at the College of Forestry, University of Washington. While there he aided in developing plans and operations in commercial thinning of Douglas firs. He also became interested in Douglas fir provenance and he assisted Dr. Stan Gessel in his first fertilization plots. Haddock remained at the University of Washington until 1953 when he joined the Faculty of Forestry at UBC to work in the area of silviculture. Throughout his career, Haddock has strived to infuse science into the art of silviculture. He is also an ardent conservationist. Although he retired from UBC in 1978, Haddock has remained active. In 1982, he coordinated and taught in a resource management course offered at Simon Fraser University.

Fonds includes: Biographical Information, General Correspondence (1937-1991), Personal Correspondence Files (1950-1985), Miscellaneous Personal Records, Course-Related Records (1954-1982), and Subject Files.

General Correspondence series. - 1937-1991.

Series consists of correspondence and other materials. Series was filed chronologically by Haddock.

Personal Correspondence series. - 1950-1985.

21 cm of textual records.

Series consists of correspondence files assembled over many years pertaining to specific individuals. The names include old friends and colleagues of Haddock and some graduate students.

Miscellaneous Personal Materials. - 1933-1977.

16 cm of textual records and published materials.

Series consists of class notes, lecture notes, field books, correspondence, printed material, essays, applications, publications, book reviews, and "Letters to the Editor" generated by Haddock as independent research material, as an undergraduate student, and during his career at the University of Washington. Series contains three subseries: Class Notes, University of Washington, and Research Material subseries.

Course-Related Records. - 1954-1982.

43 cm of textual records.

Series consists of class lists, student grades, exams, and course descriptions pertaining to Haddock's career at UBC. Series also includes materials pertaining to a Resource Management course taught by Haddock at Simon Fraser University in 1982.

Subject Files. - 1935-1991. 46 cm of textual records.

Series consists of reports, minutes of meetings, correspondence, notes, articles, conference proceedings, printed material, essays, clippings, programs, and memoranda pertaining to various topics within the area of Forestry.

Graduate Program / Students Records. - 196--1986.

12.5 cm of textual records.

Series consists of memoranda, reports, course lists, and correspondence pertaining to the Graduate Program in Forestry. Series also includes a copy of a Ph.D. thesis by Clive A. David (1986).

Speakers Bureau series. - 1976-1987. 6 cm of textual records.

Series consists of confirmations for Haddock's numerous speaking engagements conducted under the auspices of the UBC Speakers Bureau, a central "clearing house" for the numerous requests received by the university for speakers. Information includes name of the group, age range of its members, numbers expected, date, title of talk, etc. Series also includes Annual Reports and a Catalogue of Topics.
