Biographical Sketch

Henry Howard was born in Lynden, Ontario and received his early education in the Hamilton-Burlington area. He attended the University of Toronto graduating in 1940 with a B.A.Sc. in Mining Engineering. After graduation, Howard went to work for Eldorado Gold Mines Ltd. After a brief career at the Port Hope refinery, he became mill superintendent at Port Radium on the shore of Great Bear Lake in 1942. In 1946, Howard left Eldorado to become professor of Mineral Dressing in the Dept. of Mining and Metallurgy (later Mineral Engineering) at the University of British Columbia. He taught at the University for twenty-five years until his retirement in 1970.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of records documenting various facets of Howard's long career in mining- related activities. It includes material from his student days, his years at Eldorado Gold Mines, and his career as a professor at UBC. The fonds also includes photographs reflecting the development of mining equipment and technology.

Series consists of photographs document the contemporary state of mining equipment and technology through Howard's early career while working summers at Geraldton (Hard Rock Mines) and La Marque in Quebec (1937-1940) and during his equipment sales career with E. Lory of Orillia (1940-1942). Photographs from Howard's Eldorado career depict the mining operations and also capture some of the personal and social life in this remote mining community near the Arctic Circle. There are also a few photographs of laboratories and buildings at UBC and some scenes around the University.
