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# Fonds Description

**Sauder School of Business fonds.** – 1957-2015.

## Administrative History

Initial attempts to establish a commerce undergraduate degree program began in 1916 with the impetus coming from the Vancouver Board of Trade. Shortage of funds temporarily delayed the implementation of the suggested program but continued interest resulted in the introduction of five courses in 1929. In September 1939, Ellis Morrow became head of a separate Department of Commerce within the Faculty of Arts and Science. Under Morrow's direction, the department grew and in 1950, its status was changed to a school under the direction of Earle D. MacPhee. Six years later, the Senate and Board of Governors approved the establishment of the Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration, with Dr. MacPhee as Dean. UBC started helping to establish overseas business schools in 1958, starting in Malaysia, founded in 1961, and Singapore, founded in 1962. A partnership with Antai College of Economics and Management at Shanghai's Jiao Tong University was established in 2001. The faculty's name was changed to Sauder School of Business in 2003 after the largest single private donation to a business school in Canada by William L. Sauder. The graduate school was named Robert H. Lee Graduate School at the Sauder School of Business in 2006 after a donation by Robert H. Lee. A list of Faculty/School deans is available [online](#).

## Custodial History

The majority of the the materials in this fonds were acquired directly from the Sauder School of Business in several accruals. Materials in the Marketing and Communications series were acquired from the David Lam Library in 2015.

## Scope and Content

Fonds consists of textual and audiovisual materials that document the programmes and activities of the Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration / Sauder School of Business. It includes correspondence (internal and external), minutes, reports, published materials, press clippings, architectural drawings, course curricula, and one VHS video recording. It is arranged in the following series: Dean's Office – Historical, Dean's Office – Michael Goldberg Correspondence, Dean's Office – Subject Files, International Relations, UBC Administration, Faculty Advisory Board, Committees (with one sub-series), Programmes, Faculty/Programme Reviews, UBC Okanagan, Public-Private Partnerships, Commerce/Sauder Name Change, Alumni Relations, Angus Building Redevelopment, UBC Consultancy Project – Kuwait Institute of

Business and Technology (with four sub-series), Publications, and Marketing and Communications.

Records in the UBC Consultancy Project series were acquired in 2011. Some materials in the Publications series were acquired in 2012. The remaining materials were acquired in 2014-15.

## Series Descriptions

**Dean's Office – Historical series.** – 1960-1985.

22 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records which document the programmes and activities of the Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration from the perspective of the Dean's Office, and includes correspondence, reports, and minutes. It is arranged primarily by the file numbers assigned by the original office filing system, with several related, non-numbered files included at the end of the series.

**Dean's Office – Michael Goldberg Correspondence series.** – 1979-2004.

1.52 m of textual records.

Series consists of Dean's Office records created primarily during the tenure of Dean Michael Goldberg (1991-1997) and document the Faculty's activities and interests during that period, and includes correspondence, reports, and published materials. It is arranged primarily by the file numbers assigned by the original office filing system, with several related, non-numbered files included at the end of the series. Some records were stored loose, and were organized and placed in folders based on file numbers written on the records by the originating office.

Series consists of subject files maintained by the Dean's Office which document the activities, programmes, interests, and relationships of the Faculty of Commerce / Sauder School of Business, and includes correspondence (internal and external), minutes, reports, and published materials. Series consists of records which document committees within the Faculty of Commerce / Sauder School of Business, and includes minutes, reports, and correspondence. It is organized alphabetically by file title. It includes one sub-series for the Teaching Development Committee.

**Teaching Development Committee sub-series.** – 1979-1995.

13 cm.

Sub-series consists of records which document the Faculty of Commerce Teaching Development Committee, and includes minutes and correspondence. The materials were originally stored separately from files of other committees, and so they were assigned a distinct sub-series.

**Programmes series.** – 1982-2012.

1.26 m of textual records.

Series consists of records documenting academic and research programmes instituted by the Faculty of Commerce / Sauder School of Business, and includes reports, correspondence, course curricula, and published materials. It is arranged alphabetically by file title.

**Faculty/Programme Reviews series.** – 1990-2012.

35 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records documenting internal and external reviews of the Faculty of Commerce / Sauder School of Business and its programmes, and includes reports and correspondence. It is arranged in chronological order.

**UBC Okanagan series.** – 2004-2012.

36 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records that document the establishment of UBC Okanagan and its Faculty of Management, and the tenure of Sauder Dean Daniel Muzyka as Acting Dean of the UBC-O Faculty of Management, and includes correspondence, reports, minutes, and published materials. It is arranged in chronological order.

**Public-Private Partnerships series.** – 2005-2010.

32 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records which document course development and research conducted at the Sauder School of Business into the mechanics and viability of public-private partnerships (P3) for funding and operating public services and development projects, and includes reports, grant proposals, correspondence, and course materials. It is arranged primarily in chronological order.

**Commerce/Sauder Name Change series.** – 1997-2003.

1 VHS video cassette.

Series consists of records which document the Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration changing its name to the Sauder School of Business in 2003 after the donation of a \$20 million endowment by William L. Sauder. It consists of

correspondence, reports, and a video recording of the announcement of Sauder's donation and resulting name change. It is arranged in chronological order.

**Alumni Relations series.** – 1980-2008.

17 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records documenting Commerce/Sauder's relations with its alumni and with the UBC Alumni Association, and includes correspondence, reports, financial documents, and published materials. It is arranged alphabetically by file title.

Box 37(8-18)

**Angus Building Redevelopment series.** – 2006-2008.

39 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records which document the renovation and renewal of Sauder's administrative, research, and teaching space in the Henry Angus Building, and includes correspondence, minutes, architects' drawings, reports, and published materials. It is arranged alphabetically by file title.

**UBC Consultancy Project – Kuwait Institute for Business and Technology series.** – 2002-2004.

90 cm of textual records.

**Final Reports sub-series.** – 2002-2004.

18 cm of textual materials.

This sub-series consists of 18 coil-bound reports, 1 unbound report and a separate table of contents.

**Initial Proposal and Future Involvement in KIBT sub-series.** – 2002-2004.

13.5 cm of textual materials.

This sub-series consists of correspondence, minutes and notes regarding the start of the project, and notes and research regarding why they did not continue consulting the school after the final report.
