Administrative History

In 1945, the Vancouver Board of Trade passed a resolution urging UBC to establish an architecture department. Concurrently, students in second and third year Applied Science formed a Pre-Architecture Club to lobby for the implementation of an architectural program. The Department of Architecture was subsequently established in 1946 within the Faculty of Applied Science, under the direction of Frederick Lasserre. In 1950, the department was reorganized as the School of Architecture. Lasserre, who became director of the School, continued in this capacity until his tragic death in 1961. He was succeeded in turn by Henry Elder (1961-75), Robert K. Macleod (1975-79), Charles A. Tiers (acting, 1979-80), Douglas Shadbolt (1980-91), and Sanford Hirshen (1991-). Originally housed in several old army huts, in 1962 the School moved, together with the Department of Fine Arts, into the Frederick Lasserre Building. The School originally offered a five-year undergraduate programme leading to a B.Arch. degree. This evolved into a three-year second degree B.Arch. programme in the late 1950s, and further evolved as a masters level, first professional degree M.Arch. programme in the early 1990s. In 1962 a graduate-level, post-professional M.Arch. programme was first offered; in 1983 this was replaced by a Master of Advanced Studies in Architecture (M.A.S.A.) programme. The School also offers a number of workshops to its students, both locally-based programmes and "study abroad" workshops in foreign cities.

Custodial History

All but one folder of the School of Architecture records were transferred directly to the University Archives. File #1-11 was originally donated by the School to the Vancouver City Archives in 1976, and subsequently transferred to the University Archives.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of correspondence, reports, committee minutes, budget and other financial records, clippings, course materials, drawings, and photographs. The records document the evolution of the School of Architecture, its activities and programmes, and its relations with other architectural institutions and professional bodies. They are arranged in the following series: Historical Files, Building of Fine Arts Centre / Lasserre

Building, Director's Files, Possible Closure of School, Director Search, UBC Library Bookplate Competition, Course and Programme Materials, and Scrapbooks. The fonds also includes three sous-fonds (sub-groups): the papers of former director Douglas Shadbolt, records of the Architectural Undergraduate Society, and the papers of former student Peter Cotton.

Notes

The materials were received in six separate accessions, the first in 1975 and the most recent in 1997. File #1-11, originally donated to the Vancouver City Archives by the School in 1976, was transferred to the University Archives later that year.

The original order of the textual materials has been retained or restored as nearly as possible.

RESTRICTIONS: Materials containing student academic information are restricted. See the file list and series and sous-fonds descriptions for details.

Records dealing with the development of the UBC Campus may also be found in the fonds of [Physical Plant](#) and the [Department of Facilities Planning](#).

Photographs are described and stored separately. Oversized scrapbooks are stored separately in the University Archives storage area in the Rare Books and Special Collections vault.

Series Descriptions

Historical Files. - 1946-1973.

11.5 cm of textual materials.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, and clippings documenting the early history of the School. Included is correspondence and related materials from the School's second Director, Henry Elder.

Building of Fine Arts Centre / Lasserre Building. - 1957-1964.

20 cm of textual materials.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, and drawings documenting the design and construction of the Frederick Lasserre Building for the School and the Department of Fine Arts.

Director's Files. - 1970-1993.

1.54 m of textual material.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, committee minutes, budget and other financial records, clippings, course materials, and drawings. The records document the Director's role in the administration and development of the School, and the School's relations with the rest of the University, other architectural schools, and external organizations such as professional bodies and accreditation boards. They are arranged in three sub-series: School of Architecture, UBC, and External. File folders are colour-coded by sub-series, and filed alphabetically.

Possible Closure of School. - February-March 1985.

13 cm of textual materials.

Series consists of correspondence relating to a proposal to close the School in the face of cuts in funding to the University. It includes letters of support sent to the School, and copies of letters sent to the University administration opposing the proposed closure, from professional associations, other architectural schools, individual architects and architectural firms, and other concerned individuals.

Director Search. - 1968-1990; predominant 1988-1990.

8 cm of textual materials.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, and clippings, most of which served as background material in the course of the School's search for a new Director to replace Douglas Shadbolt.

UBC Library Bookplate Competition. - January-May 1978.

7.5 cm of textual materials.

Series consists of submissions for a competition to create a new bookplate design for the University Library, including graphic designs and supporting correspondence.

Course and Programme Materials. - 1963-1974.

18.5 cm of textual materials.

Series consists of course materials for several courses, tutorials, and programmes of study. The materials include course outlines and assignments, as well as curriculum proposals by professors with supporting documentation.

Scrapbooks. - 1975.

3 scrapbooks.

Series consists of three scrapbooks prepared by the School for the University's 1975 Open House. They contain clippings, correspondence, and departmental records.

Sous-Fonds Descriptions

Douglas Shadbolt sous-fonds. - 1967-1990.

3.49 m of textual materials.

Douglas Shadbolt was Director of the School of Architecture from 1980 to 1991. Born in Victoria in 1925, he went to school at UBC, McGill University, and the University of Oregon, from which he earned a B.Arch. in 1957. In 1946 he worked for a short time for renowned architect Ned Pratt at the Vancouver firm Thompson, Berwick, Pratt & Partners. Shadbolt taught at McGill from 1958 to 1961, and went on to become the founding director of the Nova Scotia Technical College's School of Architecture (1961-68), and the founding director of the School of Architecture at Carleton University (1968-79).

Sous-fonds consists of correspondence, reports, committee minutes, budget and other financial records, clippings, course materials, and drawings. The records document Shadbolt's tenure as Director of the School, as well as his own professional activities and interests. There is a great deal of overlap between records documenting these two areas of activity. They are arranged in the following series: Accreditation, Administration, Admissions, Advisory Design Panel, Architectural Institute of B.C., B.Arch./M.Arch., Budgets, CAA Visiting Board, Campus Development, Centres - Development, Continuing Education, Correspondence - General, Courses and Workshops, Dean's Office, Development Plan, Friends of the School, Graduate Programmes, Landscape Architecture, Management Committee, M.A.S.A., President's Office, Programmes, Public Relations, School Council, Shadbolt - Personal, Senate Academic Building Needs, Space and Equipment, UBC-AIBC Joint Education Committee, and University Committees. Within each series, the files are arranged in alphabetical order.

RESTRICTIONS: Files in the Management Committee series, and two files in the Admissions series, contain student academic and other personal information, and are therefore restricted.

Architecture Undergraduate Society sous-fonds. - 1953-1971.

4 cm of textual records.

The Architecture Undergraduate Society (also known as "Archus") was formed in 1955 when students from the School withdrew from the Engineering Undergraduate Society

and formed their own organization. It succeeded the Architecture and Pre-Architecture Clubs. The Society's aims are to represent the interests of students in the School, and to serve as a liaison between students, faculty, the Alma Mater Society, and the architectural profession.

Sous-fonds consists of correspondence, minutes, reports, and financial materials documenting the activities of the Society.

Peter Cotton sous-fonds. - 1947-1971.

7 cm of textual records.

Peter Cotton entered UBC as a student in 1945. In February 1946 he became the first president of the Pre-Architecture Club, formed by students interested in studying architecture. Cotton wrote to UBC President Norman Mackenzie, advocating the establishment of a department or school of architecture, and Mackenzie asked the club to collect information about anticipated costs and programme requirements. The result was the establishment of the Department of Architecture later that year. Cotton graduated with a B.Arch. in 1952, and went on to specialize in furniture design.

Sous-fonds consists of correspondence, reports, course materials and notes, and clippings.
