Administrative History

The Sustainable Development Research Initiative (SDRI) was established in April 1991 to foster policy relevant research on sustainable development. The Initiative encourages interdisciplinary collaboration among the faculty, departments and centres at UBC, as well as other institutes and programs undertaking sustainable development research in Canada and around the world. In pursuit of this, the Institute has hosted workshops and conferences, including the 1994 "Women and Sustainable Development: Canadian Perspectives" conference. It also carried out and coordinated research on sustainability and the relationships that connect and influence the environment, the economy, and society.

After an extensive review, SDRI merged with the Institute for Resources and Environment (IRE) to form the Institute for Resources, Environment and Sustainability in September 2002. SDRI was renamed the Sustainable Development Research Initiative, and continued as a major research focus within IRES.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of records which document the origins of SDRI and reflect its activities during its first five years of existence, and includes correspondence, reports, minutes, financial records, and published materials, in both textual and digital format. It is arranged in five series (Central Files, General Correspondence, UBC Correspondence, Subject Files, Research Projects) and one sous-fonds ("Women and Sustainable Development: Canadian Perspectives" Conference).

Series Descriptions

Central Files series. – 1990-1996.

2.41 m of textual records.10 computer diskettes.

Series consists of files originally kept in a numeric central filing system, and includes correspondence, reports, published materials, and minutes. File numbers range from 3.152 to 3.237, and from 4.75 to 4.120. Not all files are numbered, but they have been kept together based on their titles, contents, and their proximity within the boxes when they were transferred to the Archives.

General Correspondence series. – 1990-1996.

45 cm of textual records.

Series consists primarily of correspondence, together with related minutes and reports, and includes copies of outgoing correspondence from SDRI staff, and incoming correspondence from external (non-UBC) organizations. Files are arranged in alphabetical order.

Boxes 7(12-40), 8(1-30).

UBC Correspondence series. – 1992-1995.

10 cm of textual records.

Series consists primarily of correspondence, together with related minutes and reports, addressed to and from other UBC offices and programmes. Files are arranged in alphabetical order.

Subject Files series. – 1985, 1992-1995.

30 cm of textual records.

Series consists of reports and correspondence regarding various events, subjects and topics of interest to SDRI and its staff. Files are un-numbered and are not obviously part of the Central Files series, so they are arranged separately. Files are arranged in alphabetical order.

Research and Other Projects series. – 1988-1996.

Series consists of records documenting the origins and early development of the Sustainable Development Research Institute, as well as the various programmes and research projects with which SDRI and its staff staff have been involved. It includes reports, correspondence, financial records, and minutes.

"Women and Sustainable Development: Canadian Perspectives" Conference sousfonds. – 1992-1994.

The "Women and Sustainable Development: Canadian Perspectives" conference was initially proposed in 1992, and was held at UBC in May 1994. It was planned by a Steering Committee of grass-roots activists, researchers, public policy practitioners, and leaders of non-governmental organizations from the feminist, environment, development, and peace communities. It was led and chaired by Ann Dale, then Senior Associate at SDRI. The conference produced over 100 policy recommendations leading into the 1995 UN Fourth World Conference on Women in Beijing.

Sous-fonds consists of records documenting the planning and organization of the "Women and Sustainable Development: Canadian Perspectives" conference, including correspondence, reports, minutes, and published materials. It is arranged in two series: Conference Proposals, and Miscellaneous Files.

Series Descriptions

Conference Proposals series. – 1993-1994.

27 cm of textual records.

Series consists of records documenting the development of presentations and workshops for the Conference, and includes written proposals submitted by prospective participants and related correspondence. The files are arranged according to an alphanumeric system based on the four themes of the Conference: Women and Connectivity (CO), Women and Creativity (CR), Women and Decision-Making (DM), and Women and Economics (E).

Only accepted proposals were retained during appraisal.
