Biographical Sketch

Roy Bishop Stokes (1915-1995) received his M.A. and M. Phil. from Nottingham University. After heading the School of Librarianship at Loughborough Technical College, he came to the University of British Columbia in 1970 where he succeeded Sam Rothstein as director of the Library School. He continued in this position until his retirement in 1982. Throughout his career, Stokes was interested in bibliography and he published a number of books on the subject: *Function of Bibliography, Esdaile's Manual of Bibliography, Bibliographical Control and Service,* and *A Bibliographical Companion*. Stokes also wrote the 5th and 6th books in the Great Bibliographers series for Scarecrow Press; *Michael Sadleir 1888-1957* and *Henry Bradshaw 1831- 1886*.

Scope and Content

Fonds consists of autographs collected by Roy Stokes, book descriptions he created, various miscellaneous materials found in books, correspondence pertaining to a proposed bibliographical tour by graduate Library School students to the United Kingdom, bibliographic descriptions of books in the Colbeck Collection by both he and Library Science students, and manuscripts and correspondence pertaining to several of his publications.

There is no indication as to the date the bibliographic book descriptions were created, nor the date the autographs were collected.

Correspondence pertaining to Stokes' publications is found in the publication series, not the correspondence series.

Series consists of manuscripts, correspondence and materials pertaining to the writing and publication of several books written by Roy Stokes: *The Function of Bibliography, Esdaile's Manual of Bibliography, Sadleir 1888-1957*, and *Henry Bradshaw 1831- 1886*. The series contains a draft of an unidentified manuscript. Correspondence materials relate to the planning, research, publication, sales and reviews for the books.
