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# Fonds Description

**Stephen Straker fonds.** – 1918-1994.

1.79 cm of textual records and other materials.

## Biographical Sketch

Born in New York City in 1942, Stephen Straker became a landed immigrant in 1972. Before teaching at UBC, Straker obtained his Ph.D. degree in history of science from Indiana University in 1971: his thesis was entitled "Kepler's Optics: A Study in the Development of 17th-Century Natural Philosophy". As a professor in the UBC History Department, Straker was regarded as an interdisciplinary, collectively weaving together strands of history, philosophy, and science. He was a founding member of the Arts One program and the Science and Society Group at UBC, and in 2002, Straker was a recipient of the Killam Teaching Prize. Straker, along with Edward Levy and Catherine Crawford, became heavily involved in writing a biography about an internationally acclaimed biochemist, Juda Hirsch Quastel, who came to UBC as the first professor of neurochemistry in 1965. Straker died on July 24, 2004.

## Scope and Content

The fonds consists of correspondence from 1935-1994; research from 1942-1987; published material from 1905-1996; oral history from 1983-1987; newspaper clippings from 1964-1994; and photographs from 1923-1985.

Series consists of various publications (and some drafts) which are divided into four sub-series: publications by Straker, publications by Quastel, publications about Quastel, and miscellaneous publications. Only files containing publications (articles) by Straker or Quastel are described on an item level.

**Oral history series.** – 1983-1987.

55 cm of textual material.

95 audio cassettes.

1 video cassette tape.

Series mainly consists of interviews of Judah Quastel that were recorded by Stephen Straker and Edward Levy for Quastel's biography. The interviews cover Quastel's career in biochemistry, his pioneering in neurochemistry, and other related issues, such as soil metabolism, cell metabolism and cancer. The interviews also include other scholars and colleagues' perspective of Quastel and his research.
