Administrative History

In the years before the establishment of the Department of University Extension (1936), the University of British Columbia was engaged in three main extension activities. These included the provision of vocational courses for returning soldiers (1917-1921), the dissemination of agricultural information to the farmers of British Columbia through short courses, and the Extension Lectures Committee (1918-35) which co-ordinated lectures by university faculty throughout the province. A Carnegie Corporation grant of \$50,000 helped to establish the Department of University Extension in 1936. Robert English became its first director. Between 1936 and 1970, the Department, first under English, then Gordon Shrum and later John Friesen, expanded the scope of its activities. The department continued until 1970 when, after a period of re-evaluation, the university changed the name to the Centre for Continuing Education. This transition reflected changing public demands and a shift in emphasis toward professional and continuing academic education.

Scope and Content

The fonds consists of records generated by both the Dept. of University Extension (1936-1969) and its predecessor, the Extension Lectures Committee (1918-1935). It appears that the records were re-arranged to facilitate the writing of Gordon Selman's history of the Department, and the original order was lost. The fonds has been arranged into the following series: Extension Lectures Committee; Department annual reports; general records; professional and vocational education; the humanities and summer school; evening classes, lectures and correspondence courses; supporting services; pamphlets, brochures and course material; and Selman's own research notes. The fonds also includes a large number of photographs primarily from the 1950s and 1960s which depict campus events as well as people and buildings, as well as audio recordings of lectures and other events.

Notes

Fonds consists of institutional records – access requests must be reviewed by the University's FOIPOP Coordinator.

Series Descriptions

Extension Lectures Committee series. – 1918-1935.

50.5 cm of textual records.

Series consists of minutes, correspondence, reports, and printed material. The records document the Extension Lectures Committee and the continuing education programmes that it administered.

Department of University Extension Reports series. – 1935-1969.

24.5 cm of textual records.

Series consists of reports issued by the Department, and is arranged in two sub-series: Annual Reports, and Interim/Monthly Reports.

General Records series. – 1935-1961.

19.5 cm of textual records.

Series consists of correspondence, minutes, reports, budget records, brochures, and newspaper clippings and other printed material, and documents the activities of the Department and related offices. The records are arranged in the following sub-series: Miscellaneous, Vancouver Institute, Victoria Extension Association, Reports of the Director of Extension, "News sheet", and "Reporting on the University".

Professional and Vocational Education series. – 1938-1961.

44 cm of textual records.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, budget records, and newspaper clippings and other printed material, and documents the professional and vocational courses administered by the Department. The records are arranged in the following sub-series: Agriculture, Dominion- Provincial Youth Training Programme, Fisheries, Home Economics, Business and Industry, and Other.

Social Education, the Humanities, and Summer School series. – 1937-1957.

48 cm of textual records.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, course outlines, and newspaper clippings and other printed material, and documents the social studies, civics, and arts courses administered by the Department, as well as the summer school programme. The records are arranged in the following sub-series: Study and Study-Discussion Groups, Citizenship and Public Affairs, Citizens' Forum, Community Welfare and Recreation,

Family Life, Parent and Pre-school Education, Leadership Training and Group Development, Fine Arts, and Summer School.

Evening Classes, Lectures, and Correspondence Courses series. – 1936-1964.

12.5 cm of textual records.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, course outlines, and brochures, and documents the evening classes, lectures, and correspondence courses administered by the Department. The records are arranged in the following sub-series: Evening classes, Lecture service, Extra- sessional courses, and Directed reading and correspondence courses.

Supporting Services series. – 1938-1955.

27 cm of textual records.

Series consists of correspondence, reports, and catalogues for the support and technical services administered by the Department for its students and instructors. The records are arranged in three sub-series: Audio-visual Services, Extension Library, and Phonographic Record Loan Service.

Pamphlets, brochures and course material series. – 1955-1968.

37 cm of textual records.

Series consists of printed materials such as brochures, pamphlets, course calendars, and course outlines for programmes offered by the Department.

Gordon Selman's Research Notes series. – [1955-1956?].

Series consists of one file folder, titled "Miscellaneous", containing written and typed notes by Selman compiled in the course of writing his history of the University's extension programme.
