# Fonds Description

## **Biographical Sketch**

Gladys Wright (nee Jack) was a member of the UBC Arts Class of 1923, and later went on to a teaching career.

## **Scope and Content**

Fonds consists of a hand-written account of Gladys Wright's memories of the UBC Fairview campus. Also included are seven heavily-annotated textbooks (copies of Shakespeare's *The Winter's Tale*, *The Merchant of Venice*, *Coriolanus*, *Twelfth Night* (2 copies), *Julius Caesar*, and *Othello*) used in Garnett G. Sedgewick's English courses. The latter document teaching and note-taking methods from the 1920's, in particular those methods practiced in Sedgewick's classes.
