Guide to Wilson Recordings Collection

The Wilson Recordings Collection consists of more than 10,000 recordings, primarily of classical music, with some ethnic music and jazz.

It also includes a Show Business Collection of musical theatre, movie musicals, and other related performances.

The recordings are primarily on LP and compact disc.

LOCATION

LP's in the Wilson Recordings Collection are housed in the Automated Storage and Retrieval System (ASRS) in the Irving K. Barber Learning Centre. CD's in this collection are housed in the Reserve area behind the Circulation Desk in Koerner Library.

For LP's in the ASRS, you are required to place a retrieval request. If you have a UBC/Library card, you can do this online. (Follow the instructions at www.library.ubc.ca/home/asrs/how-to/). If you do not have a UBC/Library card, you can place your request at the Circulation Desk in the Irving K. Barber Learning Centre. A call number is required.

A CD player is available in Koerner Library. Record players are not available. There are no facilities to copy CDs or LPs.

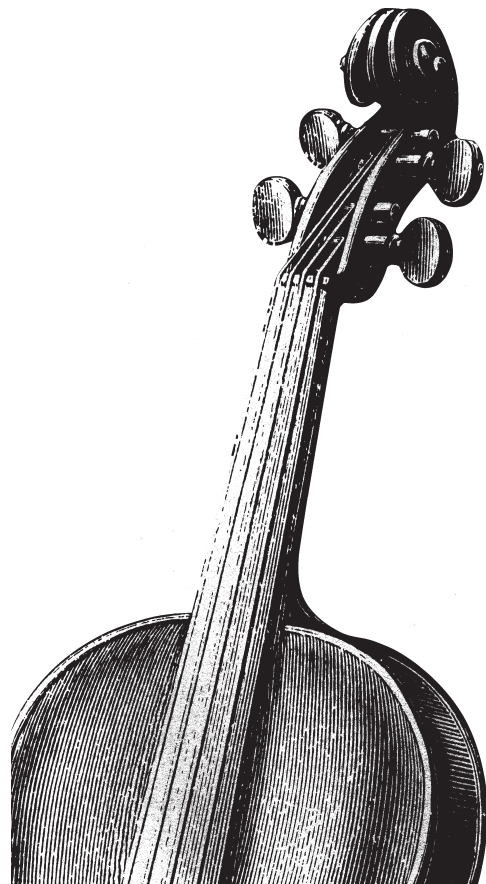
BORROWING & RENEWING RECORDINGS

Students, faculty, staff, and community borrowers may borrow Wilson Recordings Collection recordings for 2 weeks. A valid UBC/Library card is required.

Fines are charged on overdue loans. To avoid fines, return or renew recordings on time.

Recordings in the Wilson Recordings Collection may be renewed by telephone at 604.822.2883 or 604.822.3115, in person, or on the UBC Library web site at www.library.ubc.ca. Under **My Account** click on **Renew books (login)** and enter your UBC/Library card barcode and PIN.

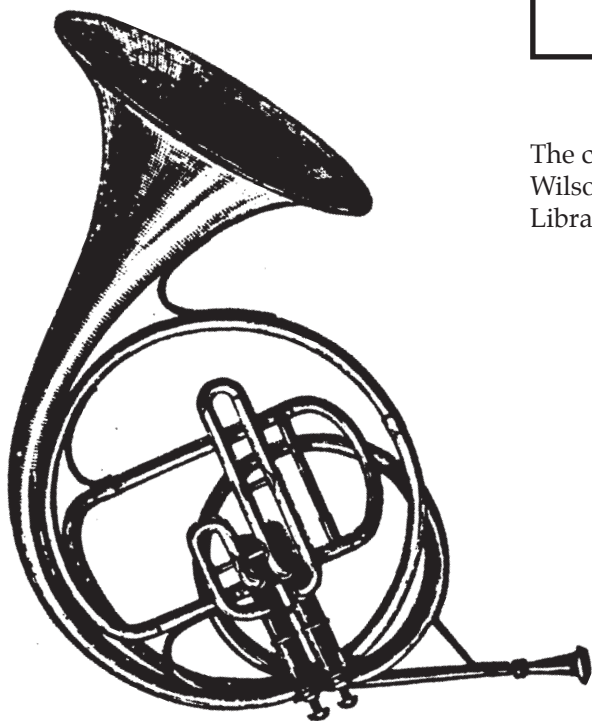

BE KIND TO OUR RECORDINGS

- ◆ to prevent scratches, return to case or sleeve immediately after playing; never leave unprotected
- ◆ avoid leaving fingerprints; handle only by edges
- ◆ clean carefully, using a soft, dry, lint-free cloth
- ◆ do not store in direct sunlight or heat
- ◆ keep and return accompanying liner notes or booklets
- ◆ before returning, check that each recording is in its proper case or sleeve
