Bio/Admin History: Harry Archibald was born in Antigonish, Nova Scotia. He graduated from McGill University with a B.A.Sc. in electrical engineering in 1898. In 1904 Archibald and his colleague Henry A. Bayfield came west to Vancouver and established an engineering firm. Archibald continued with the company until 1972. He was an active member of the Vancouver Rowing Club and YMCA and displayed a great interest in amateur athletics in general.

Scope/Content: The fonds consists of records from the Amateur Athletic Union of Canada (1910-1916), the B.C. Amateur Athletic Union (1911-1914), and the B.C. Amateur Swimming Association (1913), together with programs for athletic events (1912-1915), clippings (1913-1915), and a photograph and printed material.
