| | An unidentified letter, Ruth to Hilda, July 28, 1944, was found within the packet containing Scott to Leathart correspondence. Letters from W.M. Rossetti to Scott, n.d., and Scott to Budden, n.d., were probably enclosed with two of Scott's letters to Leathart but became separated from them. Enclosed with the letter of Oct. 4, 1861, is a descriptive catalogue of Scott's eight pictures illustrating the history of the English border, 1861. Enclosed with the letter of March 22, 1866, is a letter sent to Scott by James Smetham pertaining to a gift of etchings to Leathart. Enclosed with the letter of April 5, 1869, is a sketch of P. Poole's picture of the "Prodigal Son". Enclosed with letter of Dec. 13, 1870, is one from Leathart to Scott, Dec. 9, 1870. Enclosed with the letter of Dec. 13, 1873, is a poem taken from recitation by Scott. He stated that it might be by W.M. Rossetti. A letter to Leathart from C. Mitchell, June 31, 1878, mentioned the return of a Scott and a Cowan letter to Leathart. For their two letters, see enclosures for the letter of Dec. 20, 1877. | | |
