Introduction

This inventory describes the photographic material which is part of the Bea Millar Manuscript Collection held in Special Collections, UBC.

Biographical/historical note

Bea Millar is a Home Economist who worked for B.C. Hydro and Electric Authority in the 1960s and 1970s as a Home Service Consultant. In this capacity, Bea was responsible for coordinating the company's customer information television and radio broadcast appearances. On numerous occasions, she was the program guest. Bea was also in charge of B.C. Hydro's Educational Slide Library which contained the many slides used in their customer education programs. These programs were designed as teaching aids to provide up-to-date classroom material on energy management in the home and the efficient use and care of appliances. They were used by secondary schools around the province for classes in Home Economics. They were also popular with Adult Education and Night School Courses. Bea was a onetime chairman of the British Columbia Home Economists in Business association and a guest speaker at numerous conferences across the country on home economics.

Scope and content note

This collection consists of 248 35mm transparencies showing Bea Millar working on a television set, staff at B.C. Hydro and featuring electrical products and facilities discussed in the company's slide programs on home economic topics. The collection also consists of 30 21 x 26 cm. or smaller black and white and a few colour photoprints of Bea. The material is arranged into two series: Educational Color Slides and Photoprints.

EDUCATIONAL COLOR SLIDES [1960-1980?]

These visuals consist of phototransparencies used in consumer education and home economics classes. They mostly depict appliances of the 1960s and 1970s, explain their functions and how to use them. The phototransparencies and the two program kits which are included in this series are a sampling of the materials made by B.C. Hydro to educate homemakers and home economics students. They are Bea Millar's own set and are all that are known to exist from the slide library. Approximately 60 of the images are of Bea, staff and Home Service Centre at B.C. Hydro.
