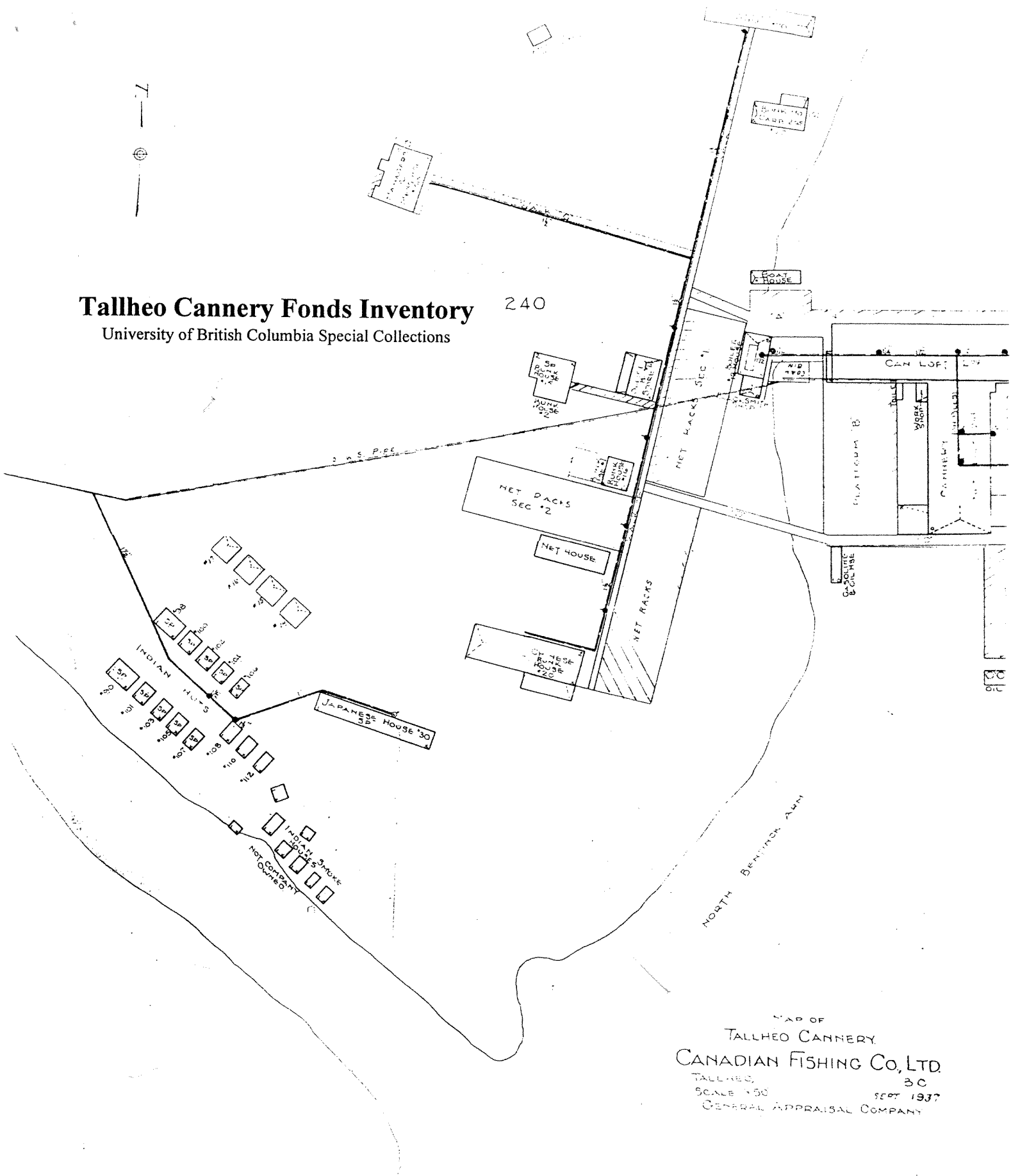

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## FONDS DESCRIPTION

**Title:** Tallheo Cannery fonds

**Dates of Creation:** 1938-1942

**Physical Description:** 54 cm of textual records

**Administrative History:** Tallheo Cannery, located near Bella Coola, British Columbia, was built in 1916 and specialized in the processing of sockeye, coho, pink, chum, and redspring salmon. The cannery was owned by Canadian Fishing Company Limited and maintained reporting relations with a head office in Vancouver.

**Scope and Content:** The fonds consists of records pertaining to the administration of the cannery. It includes financial statements, correspondence, invoices, registers, vouchers, and facilities reports. The records exist in their original chronological and alphabetical arrangement within approximately 120 folders, and appear in this inventory grouped into 12 series based upon their general functional areas. Several files contain items created by the Wales Island Cannery but incorporated into the fonds. Many items and files appear to be missing.

**Source of supplied title proper:** Title based on contents of fonds.

**Physical condition:** Many of the records are faded and have been damaged by water, mold, and rodent activity.

**Immediate source of acquisition:** Donated by Robert Critchley, January 17, 1996.

**Related groups of records in different fonds:** Information regarding other records relating to the Tallheo Cannery may be found in *Canadian Fishing Company Ltd.: An Inventory to their plant appraisements in the library of the University of British Columbia*. The CFC fonds contains five appraisements of the Tallheo Cannery conducted between 1927 and 1964. The appraisements contain summaries of physical facilities, statements on replacement values, insurance exclusions, drawings, and photographs.

## **SERIES DESCRIPTIONS**

### **Cash accounts. -- 1939. -- 0.5 cm**

Series consists of two files which cover the general accounts for the cannery and contain information on cash, assets and liabilities, operations, and stores.

### **Correspondence. -- 1939, 1941-1942. -- cm**

Series consists of miscellaneous correspondence arranged alphabetically, and telegrams received. Content includes employee relations, contractors and stores suppliers. Primarily 1939 and 1941.

### **Coupon registers. -- 1939, 1941. -- 0.5 cm**

Series consists of registry sheets which include lists of names and corresponding amounts.

### **Fisherman's statements. -- 1939. -- 1.5 cm**

Series consists of individual statements of fish catches and cash settlements. Includes records from August and September 1939 only.

### **Head Office statements. -- 1939, 1941. -- 2.5 cm**

Series consists of financial records showing all debits and credits assigned to Tallheo by the CFC Vancouver office. Records reflect level of financial authorization maintained by head office.

### **Invoices and orders. -- 1939, 1941. -- cm**

Series consists of records of services, equipment and stores purchases.

**Journal vouchers. -- 1941. -- 10 cm**

Series consists of standardized charge and credit receipts for individual employees.

**Inspection reports. -- 1938. -- 0.5 cm**

Series consists of certificates of canned salmon examination from June - September 1938. Contains information on quantity, weight, and vacuum.

**Oil Station reports. -- 1939, 1941. -- 2 cm**

Series consists of records of cannery oil and gasoline use on a weekly basis.

**Retort tallies. -- 1939, 1941-1942. -- 9 cm**

Series consists of daily inventory sheets showing number and type of fish canned, by cooler and case.

**Tax collections. -- 1941. -- 0.1 cm**

Series consists of completed British Columbia government forms including employee names, addresses and deduction amounts.

**Accident reports. -- 1939, 1941. -- 1 cm**

Series consists of accident reports and Workmen's Compensation Board applications for compensation.
