Alfred James Towle Taylor was born in Victoria in 1887. He was a prominent engineering contractor and entrepreneur. For four years during World War II he was technical adviser to the British Ministry of Production in London and Washington, D.C. He built IOCO and a number of office buildings for Imperial Oil Ltd., the Lions Gate Bridge, British Properties, Capilano Estates, and was closely involved with the Guinness family interests in British Columbia.

The maps and plans in this collection are related to the Taylor Entineering Co. Ltd. interests in the Granby Co. and its Dolly Varden Mine and related developments in the Alice Arm area. The Dolly Varden group was staked in 1910, and in 1915 the Dolly Varden Mines Company was orgainzed by Chicago, Boston, and New York interests. In 1917 the Taylor Engineering Company commenced construction of a narrow-gauge railway to the property. The cost of this construction greatly exceeded the estimate, and litigation resulted in the transfer of the mine operation to the Taylor Engineering Company. The railway was completed in 1919, and the Taylor Mining Company was organized to bring the property into production that same year. Mining was carried on until 1921. A first mortgage was foreclosed, and the property was transferred to the Northern Mines Properties, Limited.
