### **Biographical Information:**

The Western Front was founded in 1973 by eight artists who wanted to create a space for the exploration and creation of new art forms. It quickly became a centre for poets, dancers, musicians and visual artists interested in exploration and interdisciplinary practices. One of Canada's oldest Artist Run Centres, the organization is situated in a turn of the century wooden building that houses a gallery, concert hall, dance hall, and production studios for electronic and print media.

As a focal point of experimental art practice through the 1970's and 80's, the Western Front, in connection with other centres like it, played a major role in the development of electronic and networked art forms in a national and international context. This included video art, sound-art, the use of telecommunications to establish a global arts network, and the development of interactive technologies to explore the connection between the art-viewer and the art-space. In the 1990's the organization produced a number of multidisciplinary festivals and city-wide collaborative exhibitions including the Electronic Arts Festival, Reinventing the Diva, and Jiangnan.

Over the years the organization has become the training ground and springboard for many young artists, especially those working outside the commercial art market. With a staff of ten people plus interns and volunteers, the centre now produces over 100 events a year. Its artist-in-residence program invites artists from many different countries to produce new works in media/electronic art. It maintains five programs (Exhibitions, Front Magazine, Media Arts, New Music, and Performance Art), and publishes monographs, catalogues, audio works and a magazine which serves both as a newsletter to members and as a vehicle for new writing, photography and interdisciplinary performance. The Western Front maintains an extensive archive (video and audio tapes) of work created and presented over the past thirty years, and is committed to preserving the artistic legacy of Canada's artistic community.

### **Scope and Contents:**

The fonds of the Western Front consist of: administrative files including operating and project grants; correspondence; artist and project files relating to events, productions and exhibitions; and promotional and publicity materials. The materials date from 1973 to 2003. Some files include photographs and drawings.

The fonds have been arranged into nine series: general programming, administrative, exhibitions, Front Magazine, Luminous Sites, media arts and video program, new music, performance art, and publicity and promotional materials. As much as possible, the files are arranged as they were by the original curators and program administrators. Early records (1973 – 1983) for all the programs are grouped together. Video program files were separated starting in 1976 when the program began. Following 1983, the programs each had individual curators.

Approximately 16 meters of textual records in 52 boxes.

## **Series Descriptions:**

### **General Programming (1973 – 1983)**

Boxes 16, 17, 22, 23

This series consists of administrative and program files from 1973 – 1983. This includes music, performance, dance, video and exhibitions grants and projects.

### **Administrative (1983 – 2000)**

Boxes 3 to 7, 10, 21, 24, 32, 35, 36, 37, 40, 48, 60, 61

This series consists of administrative files (grants, correspondence, minutes, project information, etc.) mostly from 1983 – 2000. There is some material from the late 1970s. Projects include: Electronic Arts Festival (1995 – 1998), Art Auction and other fundraising events, and the Art Fair. Operating grants include municipal, provincial and federal funding.

### **Exhibitions (1985 – 1999)**

Boxes 2, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, 18, 38, 57, 58

This series consists of artist files, projects, promotional materials, and administrative files for the exhibitions program ("Front Gallery") from 1985 – 1999. The exhibitions program has also produced most Western Front publications (books and catalogues). Publications files from 1984 – 1989 are in box #18.

### **Front Magazine (1985 – 1996)**

Boxes 41, 50, 51

This series consists of back issues of Front Magazine from 1985 – 1996. Front Magazine started as a program guide to Western Front events in April 1985 and has since developed into a literary and arts magazine. Issues from 1985 and 1986 are in the same box (#41) with promotional material from 1981 – 1986.

### **Luminous Sites (1986)**

Boxes 19, 20

Luminous Sites was a large exhibition of Canadian video installations focusing on social forms of representation, curated by Daina Augaitis of the Western Front Gallery and Karen Henry of Video Inn. Works by ten artists were installed at galleries and public sites throughout the city. The exhibition was accompanied by Luminous Performance, curated by Glenn Lewis.

### **Media Arts and Video Art Program (1976 – 2003)**

Boxes 16, 24, 45, 63, 64, 66

This series consists of Video Program files from 1976 – 2003, including grants, artist files, projects, and artist organization files (the Western Front collaborated with many like-minded video organizations in the 1970s and 1980s). Box #24 contains the Telecommunications Art projects from 1982 – 1991 including "The World in 24 Hours" (1982) and "Text, Bombs and Video Tape" (1991). Box #63 contains the files about "Infermental VI" (Infermental was a magazine on videotape. Each issue came from a different city.) In the late 1980s, the Video Program was renamed to the Media Arts Program.

**New Music (1984 – 2001)**

Boxes 24, 25 – 29, 31, 65

This series consists of administrative and project files from the New Music program from 1984 – 2001. This includes artist files, correspondence, grants, and festival files.

**Performance Art (1979 – 2000)**

Boxes 39, 43, 44, 46, 47

This series consists of administrative and curatorial files from the Performance Art program, from 1979 – 2000. There are some photographs and drawings included. Box #47 contains files from the “Living Arts Performance Festival” (1979).

**Publicity and Promotional Materials (1975 – 1992)**

Boxes 1, 13, 18, 38, 41

This series consists of posters, brochures, press clippings, and press releases. The first two years of Front Magazine are in Box #41.
