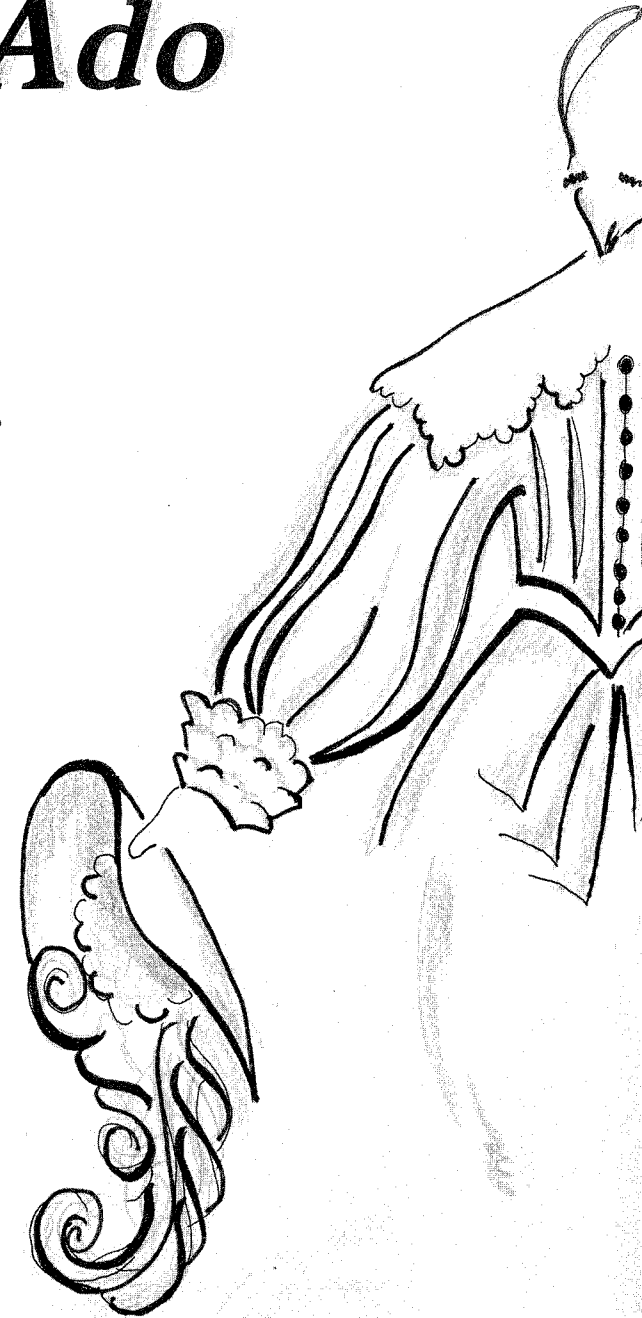

PLOT SYNOPSIS

Claudio is deceived by a plot and on his wedding day denounces Hero as unchaste. She faints and is believed dead, but recovers to be proved innocent by a chance discovery made by the local watch. Claudio and Hero and Beatrice and Benedick are happily united.
