Programme Notes

WILLIAM BUCKINGHAM, playing Sir Robert Morton. The director of "Winslow Boy" and too well known to need these few words. Has done much for the Players' Club Alumni, and is probably the Club's favorite member. He is Mr. Theatre so far as Vancouver is concerned and both the City and the Club are exceedingly lucky to have him with them.

NORMA BLOOM EDWARDS, playing Catherine Winslow. Played leading role of Helen in "Berkley Square", the Players' Club production of 1946, and the part of the siren countess in "What Every Woman Knows", their production of 1947.

MARY McLORG HILL, playing Grace Winslow. One of the Club's most talented activesses and beyond all doubt has the best disposition of any member, past or present. Was in "Pride and Prejudice", the Players' Club production of 1940, and did an unforgetable Candida in Bernard Shaw's play of the same name, the Players' Club production of 1941.

ALLAN AINSWORTH, playing Arthur Winslow. Players' Club productions: "George and Margaret" in 1943, and "The Dover Road" in 1944. Played in "The Importance of Being Earnest" for the V.L.T.A. in 1942. As if leading parts in three plays were not evidence enough of ability, he also won the Rhodes Scholarship from U.B.C. in 1946. In 1947 he played in Shaw's "Arms and the Man" with the St. John's Mummers, the oldest dramatic society at Oxford.

BEATRICE WOOD, playing Miss Barnes, the reporter. One of the founders of the Club, as well as one of its best known, most popular and most talented members. Has appeared in nearly every production the Club has made, which includes its very first, an evening of three one-act plays done in what is now the Nurses' Auditorium in the old Fairview huts, as well as its most recent — also an evening of three one-act plays, done at the University Auditorium last February.

GORDON GIBSON, playing Ronnie Winslow (The Winslow Boy). Played the leading part of Tyl-Tyl in the Childrens' Theatre production of "The Bluebird" in the fall of 1947 and was also in "Snow White" in 1948.

JOHN POWELL, playing Desmond Curry. Played the part of Rev. Alexander Mills in Players' Club production of "Candida" in 1941. Was president of the Players' Club in 1943-44. Played part of Mr. Sampson in the one-act play of that name in the Alumni Players' Club production last February. Is presently on the Advisory Board of the Players' Club.

The Women's Auxiliary to the Vancouver General Hospital

As the main objective of the Women's Auxiliary to the Vancouver General Hospital is to add to the care and welfare of the patients, most of the activities come under the broad heading of social service. Those which come within the scope of Community Chest and Council are financed by an annual grant from that agency. The others are entirely dependent upon the money-raising efforts of the Auxiliary.

Among the latter is the free library service to public ward patients, A wide selection of books and current magazines are circulated four days a week by means of a mobile library truck.

Recreational facilities of a suitable nature are provided for the psychiatric ward. Upkeep is also provided for a record-player which was donated by a women's service club in the city.

An ample supply of clothing is maintained for distribution to

destitute patients on discharge from hospital.

Books, magazines and records are supplied for the student nurses' lounge, which was furnished and is maintained by the Auxiliary.

Artificial dentures, glasses, orthopaedic and surgical appliances are supplied to indigent patients or those in very low income brackets, upon request from the doctors on the staff of the Out-Patient Department, provided they are not eligible for help from any other agency.

Extra treats at holiday seasons such as Christmas and Easter are given the children's wards and patients in Heather Street Annex,

Glen and Grandview Hospitals.

Broadway Gossip

Mr. Terence Rattigan, author of "The Winslow Boy", left New York for England a little over a week ago, having had the satisfaction of seeing his two short plays, "The Browning Version" and "A Harlequinade", a current success on Broadway. Maurice Evans and Edna Best have the leads. While "The Browning Version" is a serious offering about a defeated English school master, "A Harliquinade" is a mere trifle, a bit of theatre kidding. Mr. Rattigan also authored "O Mistress Mine", a 1946 hit with the Lunts.

"Gentlemen Prefer Blondes", a musical version of Anita Loos' novel, is opening at the Ziegfeld Theatre on Broadway early in December.

The best-seller "Cry the Beloved Country", a literary masterpiece fathered by Alan Paton, about racial tension in South Africa, has been made into an unusual musical tragedy called "Lost in the Stars."

Tennessee Williams' "A Streetcar Named Desire" has run for more than 800 performances on Broadway. Only four other non-comedies have exceeded this record—"Tobacco Road (3.182), "Angel Street" (1.295), "Anna Lucasta" (957), "White Cargo" (864); but Arthur Miller's "Death of a Salesman" which is well past its 300th showing is headed in that direction too.

A search is being made for a seven-year old lad to carry a tricky role in Carson McCuller's dramatization of the novel "The Member of the Wedding". The author of the book, Mrs. Robert Whitehead, is off for the South to look for the right boy herself. He has to be a rlaintive, curious seven year-old child - 'someone who will melt your heart' to quote director Harold Cluman.


