# Fonds Description

**Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology fonds.** – 1964-2009.

## **Administrative History**

The Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology (CTLT) was formed in July 2010 out of the Centre for Teaching and Academic Growth, and the Office of Learning Technology. The role of providing distance education at UBC was first realized through the Department of University Extension in 1936, and in 1946 the first for-credit correspondence courses were taught. In 1970 the responsibility for distance education merged into the Centre for Continuing Education, which in 1973 created the Credit and Independent Study to run correspondence courses. In 1973 Credit and Independent Study became Guided Independent Study (GIS), which was responsible for correspondence courses, while the Office of Extra-Sessional Studies was responsible for off-campus courses. In 1986 GIS was renamed UBC Access. In 1993 UBC Access, the Office of Extra-Sessional Studies and the Centre for Continuing Education merged into Continuing Studies under the authority of the Associate Vice President, Continuing Studies. In 1997 UBC Access was renamed Distance Education and Technology and in 2002 was separated from Continuing Studies to be independently run through the Vice President Academic. In 2005 Distance Education and Technology was merged into the Office of Learning Technology.

CTLT is a body under the authority of the Provost and Vice-President Academic, and their current mission is to “[advance] scholarly and innovative approaches to teaching, learning, curriculum and educational technology practices within and across UBC’s diverse disciplinary and cultural contexts.” CTLT provides four main services. It facilitates distance and blended learning, which includes course development, course planning and delivery, and instructional support. It provides professional development for instructors and graduate students (teaching assistants), and support for instructors with course technology. Lastly CTLT provides curriculum and course services, supporting the creation of new courses. CTLT also oversees the Institute for the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning (ISoTL), which runs programs and initiatives to further the scholarship of teaching and learning at UBC. CTLT is administered by a Senior Advisor of Teaching and Learning and Academic Director and four Associate Directors, as well as a Senior Manager of Planning and Operations and a Strategist for Aboriginal Initiatives.

## Scope and Content

Fonds consists of grant proposals, meeting minutes and agenda, correspondence, contracts, course materials, copyright permission forms, conference proceedings, job descriptions and applications, budgets, and employee information related to the Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology's role in course development and facilitation, supervision of graduate students, collaboration with other universities and institutions, and the Centre's internal administrative functions. The records were created between 1973 and 2007 at the University of British Columbia. The fonds is arranged into 12 series: Grant Allocation, Course Development, Professional Development Courses, Funding, Business, Distance Education Projects, International, Administration, Publicity, Post-Grad Students, Education Research, and Canadian Federal Government.

## Notes

Fonds consists of institutional records – access requests must be reviewed by the University's FOIPOP Coordinator.

The fonds was acquired from the Centre for Teaching and Learning Technologies in 2014.

Title based on contents of the fonds.

The fonds is generally arranged according to original order. A filing system was provided by the creator for several of the series or sub-series, so these units were arranged according to this system.

## Series Descriptions

**Grant Provision.** – 1997-2007.

40cm of textual records.

This series consists of annual binders from the grant allocation process conducted by the Advisory Committee on Distance Education & Technology from 1997 to 2004. These binders include grant proposals by various departments for the setting up or revision of distance education courses as well as meeting minutes and agenda of the Advisory Committee on Distance Education & Technology regarding the grant allocation process.

**Course Development.** – [1973-2006].

2.65m of textual records.

This series consists of records relating to the development and revision of correspondence courses from 1973 to 2006. It includes correspondence with course authors, copyright owners and the extension library; copyright request forms and payment information; contracts; course materials; and budget information.

This series consists of the following sub-series:

**Correspondence with Departments and Faculties.** – [1974-1999].

10cm of textual records.

This sub-series consists of correspondence with the Faculty of Arts and various departments about the provision of correspondence courses.

**Exams.** – [2002].

1cm of textual records.

This sub-series consists of records relating to the scheduling and running of exams for correspondence courses.

**Professional Development Courses.** – [2002].

1cm of textual records.

This series consists of notes and brochures containing information about the UBC Faculty Certificate of Teaching and Learning in Higher Education run by the Centre for Teaching and Academic Growth.

**Funding.** – [2000-2003].

3cm of textual records.

This series includes applications for, and communications and agreements regarding government grants for distance education projects run by various faculties or Distance Education and Technology.

**Business.** – [1991-2003].

25cm of textual records.

This series consists records relating to joint projects undertaken by Distance Education and Technology and various international businesses and organizations to run correspondence courses at UBC. These records include project proposals, reports, correspondence, and contracts. The series is arranged according to the filing system provided by the creator.

**Distance Education Projects.** – [1999-2007].

17cm of textual records.

This series consists of records of projects undertaken by Distance Education and Technology to develop the distance education program at UBC. This includes notes, reports, meeting minutes and agenda, and correspondence.

**International.** – [1990-2002].

27cm of textual records.

This series includes records relating to collaboration between Distance Education and Technology and various universities around the world to improve distance education. This includes correspondence, brochures, meeting information, conference programs and proceedings, project proposals, and reports. The series is arranged according to the filing system provided by the creator.

This series consists of the following sub-series:

**South America.** – [1990-1999].

5cm of textual records

This sub-series contains records relating to collaboration between Distance Education and Technology and various universities in Argentina, Venezuela and Brazil. It includes correspondence, meeting agenda, conference programs and proceedings, and project proposals.

**UK.** – [1995-1997].

4cm of textual records

This sub-series consists of records relating to collaboration between UBC and various universities and educational organizations in the UK. It includes correspondence, program information, and draft reports.

**USA.** – [1991-2002].

16cm of textual records.

This sub-series consists of records relating to collaboration between UBC and various universities and educational organizations in the United States. It includes correspondence, brochures, reports, and meeting information.

**Administration.** – [[1964]-2006].

30cm of textual records.

This series relates to the general administration and organization of Guided Independent Study and Distance Education and Technology. It includes correspondence, policies, reports, meeting minutes, statistics, policies and general university information from external UBC administration and internal GIS/ DE&T bodies.

**Publicity.** – [1974-2009].

6cm of textual records.

This series relates to publicity created to advertise UBC Access/ GIS Courses, and the creation of a promotional history about distance education at UBC. It contains correspondence, copyright requests, brochure drafts and final copies, as well as notes, drafts, reports and final copies of these history articles.

**Post-Grad Students.** – [1964-2003].

1cm of textual records.

This series contains records relating to the supervisory role played by Distance Education and Technology Staff for graduate students researching distance postsecondary education. It includes correspondence with these students about their status as students and progress in their research. The series is arranged according to the filing system provided by the creator.

**Education Research.** – [1994-2002].

32cm of textual records.

This series contains records relating to research about distance education that was partially funded by Distance Education and Technology or that they participated in. It includes correspondence, meeting agenda, minutes, reports, bibliographies, budgets and funding information, calls for applications for funding, project proposals and descriptions, and notes. The series is arranged according to the filing system provided by the creator.

This series consists of the following sub-series:

**NLII.** – [1983-1989].

2m of textual records.

This sub-series relates to project “Case Studies in the Benefits and Costs of Mediated Instruction and Distributed Learning” run by Frank Jewett and overseen partially by DE&T. It includes correspondence, meeting agenda, and report and review drafts.

**Research Fellows.** – [1983-1989].

1cm of textual records.

This sub-series consists of records related to the supervision and funding of post doctoral research fellows studying with Distance Education and Technology, including correspondence, guidelines, funding information, and bibliographies of writing on distance education.

**Research.** – [1983-1989].

27cm of textual records.

This sub-series consists of records relating to research projects conducted by other universities or organizations that UBC Distance Education and Technology participated in and helped to fund. It consists of correspondence,



contracts, meeting agenda and minutes, and research proposals and descriptions.

**Maple Consultants.** – [1983-1989].

2cm of textual records.

This sub-series relates to projects conducted by Distance Education and Technology in collaboration with consultants into distance learning. This consists of correspondence, calls for funding applications, project proposals, reports, and notes.

**Canadian Federal Government.** – [1996-1997].

4cm of textual records.

This series contains records relating to projects worked on by Distance Education and Technology in collaboration with the Canadian Federal Government, including “Educational Support Services Canadian Forces Continuing Education Program” and “Program for North American Mobility in Higher Education”. It includes correspondence, application information packages, project proposals, contracts, budgets and resumes. The series is arranged according to the filing system provided by the creator.
