Collection Description

English Literature Research Collection / David Macaree (collector). – [ca. 1700-1714], 1961.

Biographical Sketch

David Macaree joined the Department of English as a lecturer after he completed his M.A. at UBC. He earned his Ph.D. from the University of Washington in 1965, and became Associate Professor of English at UBC in 1970. In 1985, after his retirement, Macaree was honoured with the title of Associate Professor Emeritus of English.

Scope and Content

Collection consists of materials used by David Macaree in the course of his research on early 18th Century English literature. It includes transcribed typed copies of the complete works of David Crawford (or Crawford) (ca. 1700); a copy of an article written by Macaree about Crawford (1961); and photocopies of early political pamphlets by Daniel Defoe (ca. 1700-1714).
