Biographical Sketch

William Ridington -- also known as Robin Ridington -- joined the Department of Anthropology and Sociology at UBC in 1969 after completing his Ph.D. at Harvard. Ridington began a study of the Beaver Indians in 1964 while an undergraduate majoring in anthropology at Harvard.

The fonds consists of field notes and transcripts of interviews with the Beaver Indians.
