## **Collector's Administrative History**

The University of British Columbia Archives was established in 1970 as part of UBC Library's Special Collections Division. It serves as the University's corporate memory by identifying, preserving and making available for use the University's permanently valuable records.

Over the years, the Archives has acquired individual items, both published and unpublished, that for various reasons have been grouped together under the loose heading of "Subject Files". Together, the materials in these files provide a useful supplement to the historical information contained elsewhere in the Archives' holdings.

## **Scope and Content**

The collection consists of materials acquired by Special Collections and the University Archives and maintained for purposes of historical research. It includes reports, correspondence, committee minutes, course materials, architectural and other drawings, newspaper and magazine clippings, press releases, posters, brochures, and other published materials. The materials are arranged alphabetically by subject or name (e.g. organizations, University departments, events, buildings/places, and individuals).
