

Description: A committee composed of faculty members of the University of British Columbia investigated in 1957 the Hoxsey treatment of cancer. This investigation was undertaken at the request of the Minister of Education and the Minister of Health and Welfare of the Government of British Columbia, and was financed by them.

This accumulation of materials constitutes the background for the final report which was published by the Queen's Printer in Victoria in 1958.
